# We welcome Vicky to the NDIS Team

Welcome to Vicky Valanidas, the newly appointed NDIS Coordinator, working alongside Tracey Mitchell at St George Community. Vicky grew up in the St George region, and comes from a social work background, graduating from the University of Sydney in 2017. Throughout her degree she was given the opportunity to work at both the Royal North Shore Acute Mental Health Ward, and at the Department of Communities and Justice - Child Protection Services sector. Some of you may remember Vicky as the receptionist at Eastbrook Medical Centre in Carlton, or the girl who took your orders at Crust Gourmet Pizza Bar. Mortdale. She worked in both these roles for a very long time and became very familiar with the local area.

Following the completion of her degree, she was employed by a rehabilitation provider as a Social Worker specialising in traumatic brain and spinal injuries, amputations and burns victims. As she progressed in this role, she also began providing social work services for the elderly who were experiencing dust disease concerns. In the beginning of 2020, Vicky was providing both

counselling and social work services for a variety of workplace related injuries.

By 2021, Vicky had gained a significant insight into brain and spinal injuries and began providing case management services to injured workers. At the end of 2021, she became an independent provider and opened ViCare Support Services and



also began providing NDIS Support Coordination.

Outside of work Vicky enjoys spending time with her friends and family and giving back to the community. On Tuesday nights you will find her at Christian Aid in Minto, providing free social work services to the more vulnerable people in the community. On the weekends you will probably find her enjoying a "well-earned" ice cream at one of the local Messina stores.


