

Meet Deneice and the Leyland P76

Deneice Finn, our client pictured here, is the niece of Jack Lawler, the original owner of this Leyland P76. Jack purchased the car in 1974 when he was a Leyland dealer. The car was made in the Zetland factory in Sydney in 1974. It could hold a 44 gallon (194 litre) drum in its enormous boot.

The P76 typified Australian desires of the late 1960s – people wanted something big but economical to run. It looked different to the Chrysler, GMH or Fords in the market and it accommodated six people in comfort and was for 'Dad' to drive.

The car had innovative features like concealed wipers, side intrusion bars in the doors, a safety bonnet, front disc brakes as standard and an isolated fuel tank to meet public concerns about safety. It was also uniquely Australian in character, an enormous boot was designed to carry family luggage and camping equipment for long Australian holidays.

To make the P76 different to its American styled competitors, the Italian stylist Michelotti was employed to add some European flair to its appearance. He employed a 'flying wedge' shape, not used by other car makers such as Nissan until the 1980s.

Unfortunately, the life cycle of the car was cut short by the oil crisis, women thought the car



was too big, and this was a period of economic instability with high inflation and industrial unrest which impacted production. In November 1974 after 7 years of work, \$21 million spent in development and almost 18,000 P76s built, production ceased. Jack donated the P76 to the Powerhouse where it is now on display which Deneice spotted the minute she entered the museum on one of our social outings trips.
